Awards Guidelines

The Heart of Ohio Sussex Spaniel Club shall present award(s) to any Club member who has achieved a new title on their Sussex in the previous calendar year. HOSSC will also be honoring nominated Club members during the same time period. The award(s) will be presented at the Annual General Meeting. Documentation for each new title must be submitted by the owner. Submit all information to the Awards Chairperson. Deadline for submittal is February 1st of each year.

The Awards shall be determined by a process of application by members. Each qualifying member is responsible for submittal of the awards application. Documentation of a new title must be provided at the same time. All new title(s) will have been earned during the previous year's show calendar (January – December). All awards will be presented based on the application and documentation of new titles.

AWARDS:

Award of Achievement - Conformation (Top Dog & Bitch BREED), Performance, Obedience, Hunting/Field, Owner/Handler (Top Dog & Bitch), Search and Rescue and any new titles as recognized by AKC such as, but not limited to: Barn Hunt, Coursing, Dock Diving, and Canine Good Citizen

All new titles including titles earned from other recognized registries: UKC, NADAC, NAFA, USDAA, etc. Copies of each award/title/certificate must be submitted with the application.

Dog of the Year –The dog that has the most accomplishments for the past calendar year. New titles, participation in dog related events, public service events such as, but not limited to: nursing home visits, R.E.A.D. program, Search and Rescue missions, Acts of Heroism and participation in Meet the Breed events.

Unsung Hero Award (Human)

This will be awarded to a member who gives their time and effort to make things work for the Club. This member usually works behind the scenes and may not be present at a lot of events.

Good Sportsmanship (Human)

This will be awarded to a member who puts forth extra effort to help the Club. This person is present at most events. They show a willingness to help others and provide support to Club members at public events and shows. They exhibit good sportsmanship both in and out of the ring.
